We facilitate programs that target the root causes of community challenges and provide tools for sustainable development.





## **KEY ACCOMPLISHMENTS IN 2023**

#### YOUTH VIOLENCE PREVENTION:

Implemented culturally-responsive programs for at-risk youth, fostering positive development and resilience.

#### **STUDENT FAMILY ADVOCATES (SFA):**

Provided crucial community-based advocacy support to Black students and families.

#### YOUTH VIOLENCE AND HUMAN TRAFFICKING PREVENTION (YVHTP):

Empowered youth in Canlish and Glamorgan communities through collaborative programs.

#### **BLACK EMPLOYMENT SUPPORT PROGRAM:**

Promoted life skills and employment readiness at detention centers, aiding reintegration and reducing recidivism.

#### **COMMUNITY MOBILE UNIT:**

Retrofitted a motorhome to deliver essential services to socioeconomically challenged communities, fostering engagement.

#### STREET ENTREPRENEURS:

Launched a national project-based learning initiative, equipping Black youth with entrepreneurial skills.

#### **TIDY-UP TIME:**

Provided opportunities for justice-impacted individuals through our social enterprise program.









#### **LIVE AFTER 5IVE:**

Enhancing community engagement and support beyond regular hours.

#### **WRAPP360:**

Implementing a mobile application for improved accessibility and user engagement.

#### **CSE (COMMUNITY SUPPORTED EMPLOYMENT):**

Establishing community-supported employment opportunities.

#### **WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT:**

Focusing on skills and career growth for community members.

#### **TRANSITION HOUSING:**

Addressing transitional housing needs for returning citizens in our community.

#### **SAY IT LOUD FOR RETURNED CITIZENS:**

Advocacy and support program for reintegrating citizens.





## PROGRAM MONITORING AND EVALUATION


In 2022, we initiated a comprehensive program monitoring and evaluation process to:

- 1. Assess the fidelity, quality, and impact of our training and intervention programs.
- 2. Engage learners in program enhancements via feedback.
- 3. Strengthen our programs through evidence-based approaches.



Focused on the family and educational background, adverse childhood experiences, incarceration history, and motivation to participate in our programs. A total of 213 learners across seven sites participated in this assessment.

### **FINANCIAL OVERVIEW**



#### **REVENUE GROWTH:**

In 2023, Urban Rez Solutions saw a substantial increase in revenue to \$1,646,100, primarily due to significantly higher government grants. This compared to \$876,797 in 2022, showcasing successful efforts in securing increased funding.

#### **EXPENSE CONTROL:**

Total expenses amounted to \$1,463,341 in 2023, up from \$822,009 in 2022. Despite higher expenses in areas such as advertising, consulting, and program costs, resources were managed effectively, resulting in a surplus of \$182,759.

#### **FOCUSED INVESTMENT:**

Strategic investments in key areas to support growth and mission. Notable increases in expenses included advertising and promotion (\$75,502), consultants (\$192,710), and program costs (\$971,565).



#### **STRONG FINANCIAL HEALTH:**

Net assets grew significantly, increasing from \$347,983 at the beginning of the year to \$530,742 by year-end 2023. This growth reflected robust financial health and prudent management of resources.
